EXCURSIONS/CAMPS

Excursions and camps are a crucial part of the learning experience of all our students at Chatham. They support opportunities that are not necessarily available in the classroom.

Volunteers offer support to our teachers by providing appropriate supervision and assisting with various tasks so that our students can build resilience, confidence and problem-solving abilities.

CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

Class representatives are the personal liaison between your child's teacher, the school and the families of your child's class.

ENGLISH/MATHEMATICS

This role involves helping our students within the classroom environment by working in small groups or providing one-on-one support and assisting the classroom teacher.

All classroom volunteers undertake the Classroom Helpers' Course prior to being involved in learning experiences with our children.

SPORTS DAYS

Sporting days are generally organised by the school, but require the support of volunteers to ensure they run smoothly. They are a great opportunity to offer assistance to the event organisers with dedicated tasks whilst enjoying the carnival atmosphere that comes from seeing all the students participate in various sporting events.

All students are involved in house and interschool sports.

CHICKENS

Chickens are an integral part of the Chatham family. To ensure the care of our chickens continues at a high standard, Chatham requires volunteers to undertake various tasks.

Two volunteers are required to job share over seeing the care of the chooks all year round. This position requires the leaders to:

- oversee the chook care, ensuring the chooks are locked into their coop each afternoon
- induct the Year 6 Environment Leaders into caring for the chooks
- purchase the chook food and straw
- take them to a vet if needed
- arrange for the sign-up volunteer roster to be created
- fill in gaps in the roster when they occur

Other volunteers are required to care daily for the chooks on weekends, curriculum days and school holidays using the sign-up roster.


